Memorial of St Francis De Sales, Friday 24th

Born in 1567 in France St Francis fought Calvinism with apostolic zeal. He wrote the "Introduction to the Devout Life" a classic of Spiritual direction. He died in Lyons in 1622 and was Canonised in 1655. In 1877, Pope Pius IX proclaimed him a Doctor of the Church.

This is his prayer:

Be At Peace

Do not look forward in fear to the changes in life; rather, look to them with full hope that as they arise, God, whose very own you are, will lead you safely through all things; and when you cannot stand it, God will carry you in His arms.

Do not fear what may happen tomorrow; the same understanding Father who cares for you today will take care of you then and every day.

He will either shield you from suffering or will give you unfailing strength to bear it. Be at peace, and put aside all anxious thoughts and imaginings.
